

Summary of quick test options in Rottenburg

Notes: FFP2 masks must be worn in all test stations. The tests are basically free of charge.

PCR tests at the doctor's and at the fever clinic

All of the offers listed below are quick tests that are provided free of charge to citizens. Anyone who is considered to be the direct contact person to an infected person (so-called category I persons) or who has symptoms typical of corona such as fever, cough and runny nose should go to the doctor or do a PCR test at the fever clinic (Tübingen fairground). According to the health department of the federal state of Baden-Württemberg, a smear test for diagnostics from the 5th to 7th kDay after first contact with the ill person.

1. Zehntscheuer (Bahnhofstraße 16):

Here quick tests for self-application can be carried out under the supervision of trained persons. It is not necessary to make an appointment.

2. Youth Centre „Klausse“ (Schadenweilerstr. 11A):

Qualified persons do the corona rapid tests. It is advisable to make an appointment using the online calendar. If you come without making an appointment, you may have to undergo waiting times outside the youth center.

3. Senior Citizen Centre „i-Dipfele“ (Königsstr. 84):

Continuous testing of employees and visitors in nursing homes takes place in the senior citizen centre. Appointments are linked to visits to the nursing homes.

4. Test container on the Lidl parking lot (Graf-Bentzel-Straße 22):

Quick tests are possible on the Lidl parking lot without prior reservation.

5. Drive-in quick tests on the Globus car park (Felix-Wankel-Straße 22):

Tests can be carried out in the building centre's parking lot.

6. In addition, in (almost) all villages or suburbs respectively of Rottenburg there are now opportunities to be tested at least once a week
